EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. For Eyes and Skin: Rinse eyes or skin immediately with water for at least 15 - 20 minutes. For Ingestion: Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. DO NOT induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

For Inhalation: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
